Notice of Race

1. EVENT & RULES

- 1.1 The XVII Bay of Cadiz New Year Regatta, "XII Kim Lythgoe Memorial Race", Andalusian Cup for the following Classes: RS:X M, W & Youth under19, ILCA 7 Men, ILCA 6 M/W, Raceboard, ILCA 4 B/G, 420 M/W and Techno 293
- O.D boys and girls (Under 15, 17 and 19), Techno Plus and iQFOIL, will be held from 27 >30 December 2020.
- 1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, including

Appendix B "Windsurfing Competition Rules" for the RS:X, Raceboard ,Techno and iQFOIL Classes and,

- 1.3 Safety Protocol to avoid the spread of COVID 19 published in the regatta web.
- 1.4 [DP] Class Rules
- 1.5 [DP] Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS)
- 1.6 The "Competitions Rules" of Andalusian Sailing Federation for Andalusian Cup.
- 1.7 Spanish is the official language of the Race.
- 1.8 [NP][DP]RRS 40 "Personal Flotation Devices" shall applies at all times while afloat.
- 1.9 [NP][DP]All the competitors and support person shall follow any reasonable instruction given by a member of the OA.
- 1.10 In all rules governing these Championships [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).











2. ORGANISER

2.1 The Race will be organized by The Andalusian Sailing Federation and El Puerto de Santa María City Hall with the sponsorship of the "Consejería de Educación y Deportes de la Junta de Andalucía" and the Diputación Provincial de Cádiz".

3. VENUE

3.1 The venue of the race is "Puerto Sherry" in El Puerto de Santa Maria which is located about 2 hours by car from Seville and 30 minutes from Jerez Airport by car.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 All the competitors and coaches shall entry through the following link: https://regatas.fav.es/es/default/races/race/text/regata-internacional-new-year-race-2020-es
- 4.2 The entry fees are:
 - Early Entry Fees (before 10 December 2020): €50 per boat/coach.
 - Later than 10 December 2020: €75 per boat/coach.

5. CLASSES & DIVISION. ELEGIBILITY

- 5.1 ILCA 7 men
- 5.2 ILCA 6 men and women
- 5.3 RS:X men & women
- 5.4 iQFOIL men, women and youth
- 5.5 RS:X Youth 8.5 sailors shall be under the age of 19 years on 31 December 2020. Sails 8.5m2 and 60 cm fin.
- 5.6 Techno 293 O.D. in the following Divisions
- o Techno 293 OD under 15 (boys and girls) years old with sails up to 6.8 m2 (Born in or after 2006 and not later than 2010))
- o Techno 293 OD under 17 (boys and girls) years old with sails up to 7.8 m2 (Born in 2004 and not later 2008)
- o Techno 293 OD under 19 (boys and girls) years old (Born in 2002 or 2003)
- 5.7 ILCA 4 boys and girls
- 5.8 Raceboard
- 5.9 420 men & women
- 5.10 Techno Plus
- 5.11 The XVII Bay of Cadiz New Year Regatta, "XII Kim Lythgoe Memorial Race" is an "open" event.
- 5.12 At least 10 starter boats in one race are required to constitute a valid Class or Division.
- 5.13 All the Spanish sailors, with legal residence in Spain or representing a Spanish Club shall be in possession of the RFEV Spanish Licence. Foreign sailors shall be covered by a Third Party Insurance of minimum 330.550€ and accidents or injury during the regatta

6. SCHEDULE

6.2 Number of races scheduled are 9, except for iQFOIL class that 12 races are scheduled. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

7. REGISTRATION ON SITE

- 7.1 The race office during the regatta will be at the 1st floor of the High Performance Center of the Andalusian Sailing Federation. Please contact at racing@fav.es before the event for further information and enquiries.
- 7.2 Each Competitor shall produce the following documentation before <u>20:00 on 27 December</u> in the Race Office
 - Original Regatta Entry Form.
 - Personal Location Form for each sailor
 - Proof of Entry fee payment.
 - Proof of valid third party insurance and accidents(only will be accepted in English or Spanish)
 - Sailing Federation Licence 2020 (for Spanish sailors)
- 7.3 All the coaches must be registered by the time of the previous article in the Race office, producing the following documents.
 - Registration Form
 - Personal Location form
 - Technical Spanish Licence 2020 (only for Spanish coaches)
 - Valid third party insurance and navigation licence of the support boar.
 - Proof of Entry fee payment
- 7.4 In the 420 Class only the skipper shall steering the boat

8. PRIZES

8.1 The prizes list will be posted on the Official Notice Board before the start of the 1st race.

9. LIABILITY

9.1 Competitors take part in all races at their own risk. The Organising Authority or any of their officials or representatives or sponsors or their officials or representatives are not responsible, under any circumstances, for any damage, loss or injury either ashore or on the water either to persons or equipment, which may result. Participation in this event, supporting events and in each race in them is at the sole discretion of the sailor and at his/her own risk. Notice is drawn to RRS 4.

10. [NP][DP] MEDIA RIGHTS

- 10.1 All competitors, boat owners, helmsmen/women, crew members and support personnel taking part in the regatta or being on board participating boats, and as mandatory requirement for the correct entry, grant the organising authority with no cost whatsoever, the regatta image rights and consent to the use of their name, voice, photographs, videos, biography information, as well as the representation of boats in any digital, written or internet media with the purpose of advertising, promoting, making a documentary and any other kind of communication related to the referred regatta.
- 10.2 The top three competitors as well as the individual race winners may be required to attend a media press conference each day.
- 10.3 Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta.
