## **Notice of Race**

In all rules governing this regatta [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

#### 1. EVENT & RULES

- 1.1 The XIX Bay of Cadiz New Year Regatta, "XIV Kim Lythgoe Memorial Race", Andalusian Cup for the following Classes: Raceboard, ILCA 7 men, ILCA 6 m&w, ILCA 4 m&w, 420, Techno 293 O.D. boys and girls under 15&17, 420, iQFOIL m/w/ under 19 & under 17 Classes. The regatta is organised by Federación Andaluza de Vela and El Puerto de Santa María Council with the sponsor of Consejería de Turismo, Cultura y Deporte of the Junta de Andalucía, Diputación Provincial de Cádiz, Cobra Semirígidas, Murimar Seguros and Marina Puerto Santa María.
- 1.2 The regatta will be held in the venue of the Andalusian Sailing Federation in Puerto Sherry, El Puerto de Santa María, from 27 to 30 December 2022.
- 1.3 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, including Appendix B "Windsurfing Competition Rules" for the Raceboard, Techno, iQFOIL Classes and,
- 1.4 [DP] Class Rules
- 1.5 [DP] Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS)
- 1.6 RRS 90.3(e) applies
- 1.7 The "Competitions Rules" of Andalusian Sailing Federation for Andalusian Cup.
- 1.8 Spanish is the official language of the Race.
- 1.9 [NP][DP]RRS 40.1 "Personal Flotation Devices" shall applies at all times while afloat.
- 1.10 [NP][DP]All the competitors and support person shall follow any reasonable instruction given by a member of the OA.

#### 3. CLASSES & DIVISION, ELEGIBILITY

- 3.1 ILCA 7 men
- 3.2 ILCA 6 men and women
- 3.3 ILCA 4 boys and girls
- 3.4 iQFOIL men, women
  - o iQFOIL under 19 (M&W) sailors shall be under the age of 19 years on 31 December 2021
  - o iQFOIL under 17 (M&W) sailors shall be under the age of 17 years on 31 December 2021.
- 3.5 Techno 293 O.D. in the following Divisions
  - Techno 293 OD under 15 (boys and girls) years old with sails up to 6.8 m2 (Born in or after 2008 and not later than 2011).
  - o Techno 293 OD under 17 (boys and girls) years old with sails up to 7.8 m2 (Born in 2006 and not later 2010)
- 3.6 Raceboard
- 3.7 420
- 3.8 The XIX Bay of Cadiz New Year Regatta, "XIV Kim Lythgoe Memorial Race" is an "open" event without limitation in the number of entries. This changes rule 1.10.3(a) of the Competitions Rules of the Andalusian Sailing Federation.
- 3.9 At least 10 starter boats/boards in one race are required to constitute a valid Class or Division.
- 3.10 On 1st March 2022, World Sailing, published the following recommendations in reaction to the situation in Ukraine: <a href="https://www.sailing.org/2022/03/02worldsailing-statement-6">https://www.sailing.org/2022/03/02worldsailing-statement-6</a>/. After this, the Consejo Superior de Deportes of Spanish Government and Real Federación Española de Vela published recommendations in the same line. To help preserve the integrity and safety of this event the organising committee does not accept competitors holding only Russian or Belarussian nationality.

The Organising Authority will be monitoring the situation and will adapt recommendations and measures according to future developments for this event.

3.11 All the Spanish sailors, with legal residence in Spain or representing a Spanish Club shall be in possession of the 2022 RFEV Spanish Licence. Foreign sailors shall be covered by a Third-Party Insurance of minimum 350.550€ and accidents or injury during the regatta

4.2 Number of races scheduled are 9, except for iQFOIL class that **15 races are scheduled**. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.















#### 5. REGISTRATION ON SITE

- 5.1 The race office during the regatta will be at the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the High-Performance Centre of the Andalusian Sailing Federation. Please contact at <u>racing@fav.es</u> before the event for further information and enquiries.
- 5.2 Each Competitor shall produce the following documentation before 19:00 on 27 December in the Race Office
  - Original Regatta Entry Form.
  - Proof of Entry fee payment.
  - Proof of valid third party insurance and accidents (only will be accepted in English or Spanish)
  - Sailing Federation Licence 2022 (for Spanish sailors)
  - ID Card or Passport
- 5.3 All coaches must be registered by the time of the previous article in the Race office, producing the following documents.
  - Registration Form
  - Technical Spanish Licence 2022 (only for Spanish coaches)
  - Valid third-party insurance and navigation licence of the support boat.
  - Proof of Entry fee payment
  - ID Card or Passport
- 5.4 In the 420 Class only the skipper shall steering the boat.

#### 6. PRIZES

6.1 The prizes list will be posted on the online Official Notice Board no later than one day before the end of the race.

#### 7. RISK STATEMENT

- 7.1 Competitors and support team participate in the championships entirely at their own risk and they are reminded of the provisions of RRS 3, Decision to Race. Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
- 7.1.1 They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- 7.1.2 They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore.
- 7.1.3 They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- 7.1.4 By participating in any race, they are satisfied that their boat is in good order, complying with the class rules, is equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate.
- 7.1.5 The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, umpires and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities.
- 7.1.6 The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
- 7.1.7 It is their responsibility to familiarize themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue/event and attend any venue/event safety briefings held for the event.















### 8. [NP][DP] MEDIA RIGHTS

- 8.1 All competitors, boat owners, helmsmen/women, crew members and support personnel taking part in the regatta or being on board participating boats, and as mandatory requirement for the correct entry, grant the organising authority with no cost whatsoever, the regatta image rights and consent to the use of their name, voice, photographs, videos, biography information, as well as the representation of boats in any digital, written or internet media with the purpose of advertising, promoting, making a documentary and any other kind of communication related to the referred regatta.
- 8.2 The top three competitors as well as the individual race winners may be required to attend a media press conference each day.
- 8.3 Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta.
